# **2.** Review of minutes of May **3**, 2019 meeting. *Motion to accept the minutes made by C. Gibson, seconded by C. Rembold, and approved 3-1-0, with S. Shatz abstaining.*

**3.** Executive Session – for legal strategy, mediation and meeting/conferring with mediator. N. Karns requested a motion to go into Executive Session for mediation regarding the EPA Rest of River clean-up and the appeals of the EPA's Permit and the EAB decision and to meet or confer with a mediator as defined in s. 23C of MGL C 233, with respect to any litigation or decision on any public business within its jurisdiction involving another party, group or entity; such discussion, if held in open meeting, may have a detrimental effect on the legal position of the Rest of River Municipalities' legal action with EPA and GE. The Rest of River Committee will reconvene in regular session. *A motion made by R. Wood and seconded by C. Rembold, for the Committee to enter into Executive Session, as stated above and to return to open session, carried unanimously with the following roll call vote: P. Carlino, Lee, AYE; C. Gibson, Lenox, AYE; C. Rembold, Great Barrington, AYE; and R. Wood, Sheffield, AYE. The Committee went into Executive Session at 9:03am.* 

The Committee returned to open session at 10:48am. Discussion ensued as to location of next meeting, May 17<sup>th</sup> at 9am, with Stockbridge Town Offices as 1<sup>st</sup> choice and BRPC as 2<sup>nd</sup> choice.
