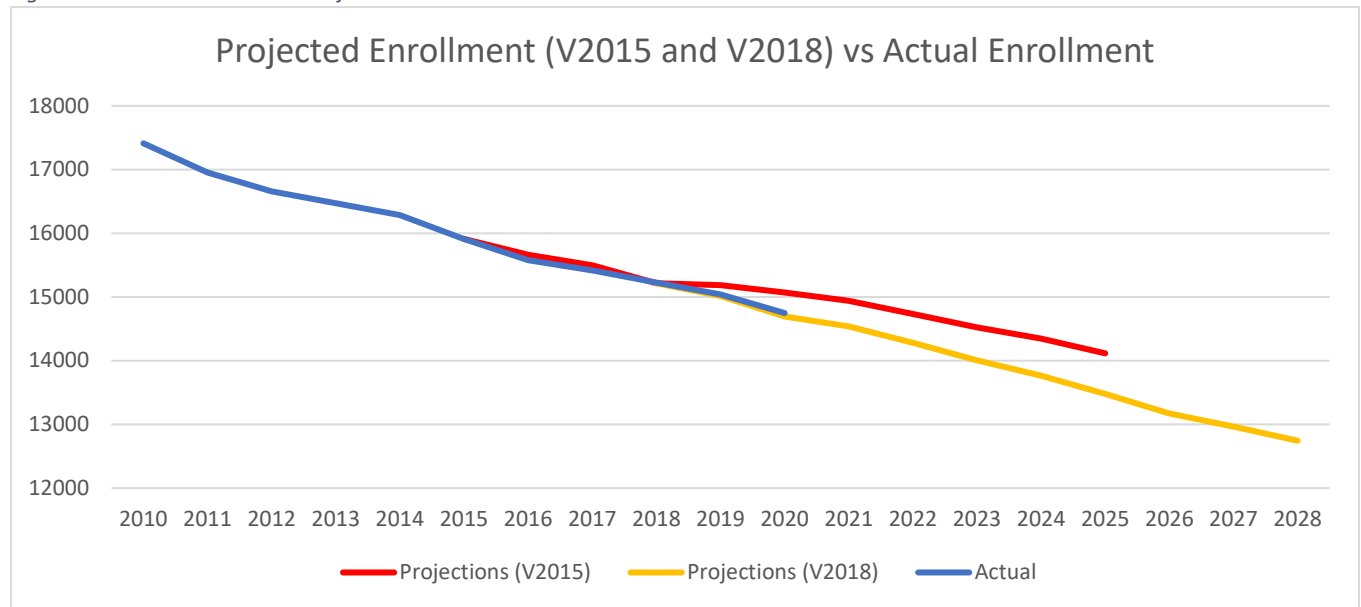

### County Projections

In 2015, the Berkshire Regional Planning Commission released the “Berkshire Public School Enrollment Trends” report, which reviewed current enrollment trends in the county as well as projecting future enrollment out to 2025 based on births and year-to-year grade changes. Updates to the 2015 projections were done in 2018. In the 2 years since the 2018 report, the trends at the county level have mostly remained the same, with the 2018 projections for 2020 being 55 students less than actual. The enrollment in 2020 is 322 students less than projected in 2015; therefore, the corrections to the model made in 2018 were justified (Figure 1). In 2020 there was a total of 14,748 students enrolled in public schools for kindergarten through grade 12.

Figure 1. Actual Enrollment vs Projected



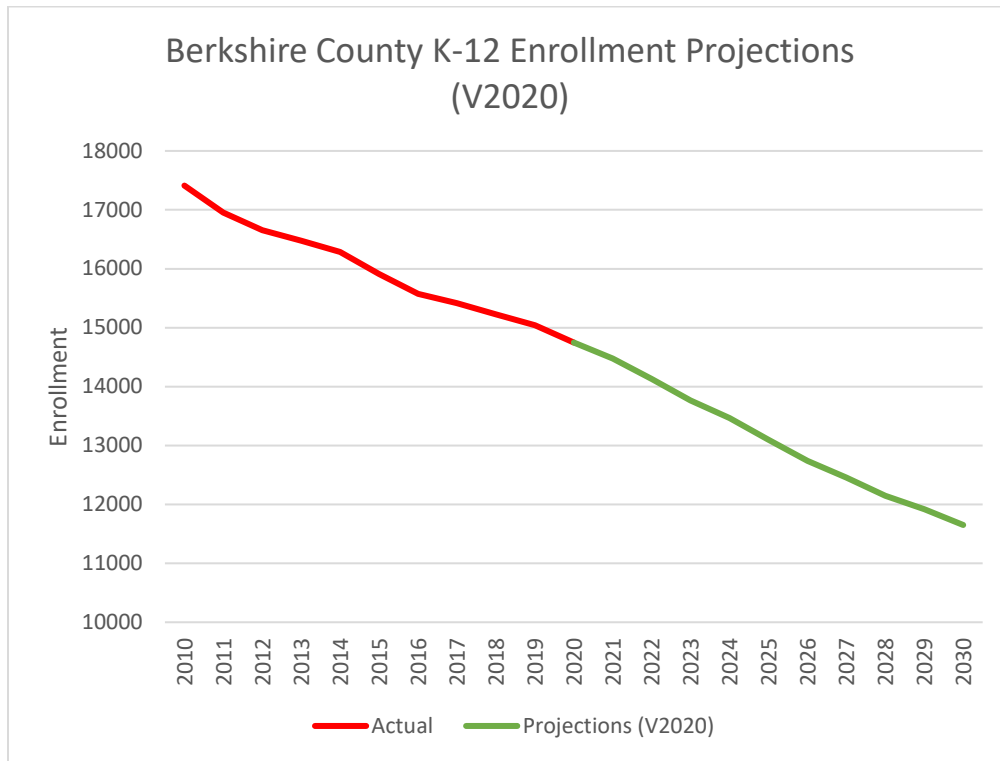
The new V2020 projections, which run from 2020 – 2030, incorporate one more year of births and two more years of enrollment trends. The enrollment data shows that there are slightly more students moving out/choosing out of the county than the two previous years; however it was significantly less than 4 or more years ago. The birth data shows a steeper decline than the V2018 projections, however county-wide birth data for two additional years that are not year available at the town level, show an even more significant decline and total births now being below 1,000 births /year. Student movement between grades impacts the short-term projections; however births have a more significant impact on long term projections. With steeper declines to births, the new projections show a slightly more significant decline in enrollment. Overall, by 2030, Berkshire County is projected to have a K-12 Public School Enrollment of 11,651, which is 3,097 less than the 2020 enrollment, a decline of 21% (See Table 1 and Figure 2). These projections, based on existing 5-year trends, are only projections and should not be assumed to be perfect. As with any projection, the further out from the baseline (2020), the higher the chance of error. Any changes locally, regionally, or nationally, to birth rates, moving rates, and even the economy, can cause these projections to be incorrect.

Figure 3. Enrollment Projections (V2015, 2018, 2020)

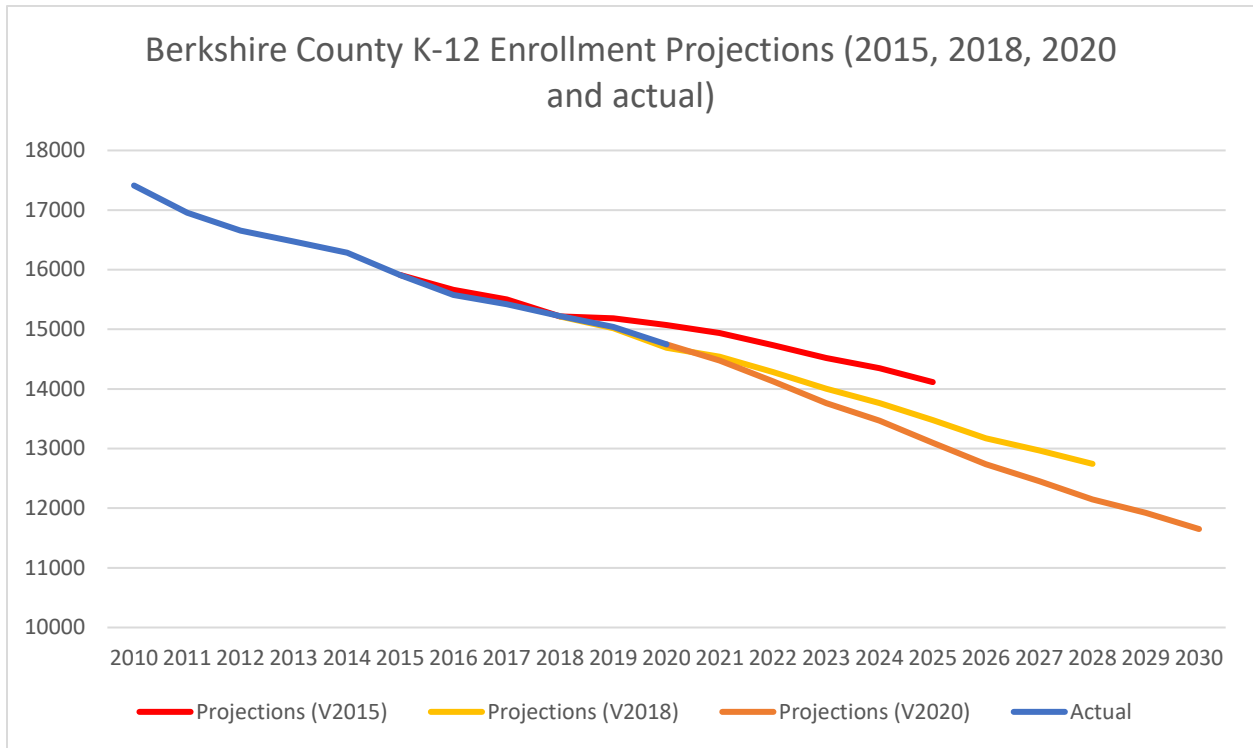
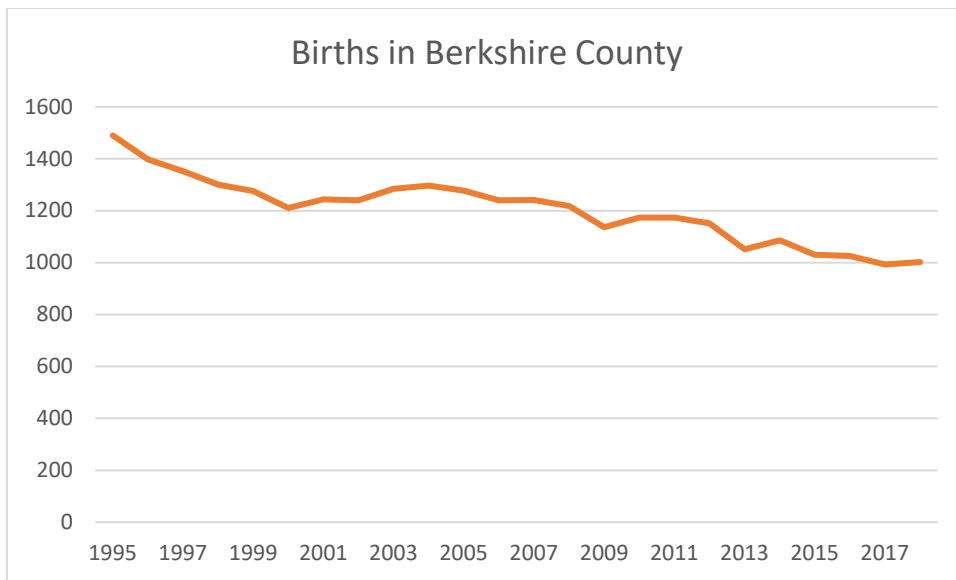


Figure 4. Births in Berkshire County

### School District Projections

In reviewing the 2020 actual enrollment to the V2018 projections, while the county numbers are close, the individual school districts varied from the V2018 projections, mostly due to changes in migration into and out of the district (Table 3).

The new projections (V2020) are shown in Table 3 and take into account any changes in births and in/out-migration and choice into neighboring districts. It is important to note that given the small size of many districts, these school district level projections have a large margin of error. A change of one or two students can have a significant impact on the projections.

The Berkshire Arts & Technology Charter School had significantly more than projected; however this is mostly due to the school having gone through a physical enlargement. The projections for BART for 2030 show only a slight increase from their current level (8 students for a 1.9% increase)

In 2020, the Berkshire Hills Regional School District had 11 fewer students enrolled than projected. It appears that the district had fewer students moving into the district for kindergarten than projected. The district is projected to continue to lose students throughout the grades, however more so in the middle and high school grades. Overall, the district is projected to lose 279 students between 2020 and 2030. The projected enrollment amounts to a 24% decline in enrollment.

The Central Berkshire Regional School District had 58 more students than projected for 2020. The district had more students move into the district for kindergarten than projected. They also had a very stable enrollment over the last two years among all grades. The district is projected to continue to lose students, especially amount the early elementary years and the late middle/early high school years. The district is projected to lose 187 (12%) students between 2020 and 2030.

## Berkshire County Public School Enrollment Projections (V2020)

The Clarksburg School District saw an increase of 4 students, which was 2 more than projected. By 2020, the district is projected to lose another 7 students. Overall, Clarksburg appears to be a stable district with minor fluctuations each year.

The Farmington River Regional School District saw a decline of 11 students since 2018, 2 more than projected. The district is projected to lose 31 (38%) students between 2020 and 2030. The district is seeing a slight decline in births but is experiencing a steady trickle of students leaving each year from each grade.

The Florida School District grew by 5 students between 2018 and 2020, which is five more than projected. This growth is due to a spike in births in 2015, which resulted in a larger Kindergarten class than projected. The district is projected to lose 35 (48%) students between 2020 and 2030, mainly due to declines in the number of students in the older grades and a continued decline in births.

The Hancock School District had 14 more students in 2020 than projected. This increase is due to a slight increase in the number of births in Hancock as well as a spike in the 2020 Kindergarten class. With births trending upwards, the 2030 projection calls for an increase of 14 students or 36%.

In the Hoosac Valley Regional School District, there were 58 fewer students enrolled than projected. This decrease in enrollment is seen across the grades. The district has seen more births than initially projected, so that has a positive influence on the projections. The district is projected to lose only 24 (-2.3%) students between 2020 and 2030 because of these births.

The Lee School District had 38 more students than projected for 2020. The district continues to see fewer students moving out than projected, a significant increase in students in 9<sup>th</sup> grade, and a slight increase in births. The district experiences a wide fluctuation with the number of births each year, with the last five years showing as many as 62 births and as few as 31 births. This variability makes the development of accurate projections problematic; however the projections for 2030 show a loss of 98 students, or -14%, mostly amount the elementary school population.

The Lenox School District saw 37 more students enrolled than projected in 2020. The district is seeing more students moving in/choosing in than projected throughout elementary school than projected. Lenox still faces challenges with the number of births declining by over 50% by 2030. With limits on the percent of choice students allowed, the district is projected to see a decline of 99 students or 13% of the student population by 2030.

The Mount Greylock Regional School District saw 8 more students than projected in 2020. Overall, Mount Greylock is projected to lose 346 students by 2030, or -31%. The school district continues to show students moving out of the district among middle and high school grades. The district also is experiencing a slight decline in births.

The North Adams School District saw 53 fewer students than projected. This difference is due to a steep decline in births as well as more students moving out/choosing out than projected. The district is projected to lose 531 students (43%) by 2030 due to the decrease in births and an increase in students moving out. These declines may only be 1-2 year trends; however, more data over the coming years is needed to determine if this is accurate.

## Berkshire County Public School Enrollment Projections (V2020)

The Northern Berkshire Vocational School District saw 1 less than projected, but has a stable enrollment now and projected into the future.

The Pittsfield School District had precisely the number of students as projected for 2020; however the projections had lower enrollments for the elementary schools and lower enrollments among middle and high school students than projected. Pittsfield is projected to lose an additional 1,329 students by 2030 or -26%. This decline is due to a continued decline in the number of births within Pittsfield and continued moving out/choosing out at all grades, especially at the 6<sup>th</sup>-grade level.

The Richmond School District saw 13 fewer students than projected. This decrease is due to a slight dip in births and slightly more students who moved out/choiced out from 3<sup>rd</sup> grade and above. The district is projected to see a gain of 79 (51%) students by 2030 due to an increase in births, however as the district receives many choice students, they may limit the number of new choice students and thus reduce its projected enrollment.

The Savoy School District saw exactly the number as projected for 2020. The district continues to see a decline in the number of births; however it is seeing fewer students move/choice out than previous years. The district is projected to lose 7 students by 2030, a decline of 15%.

In 2020, the Southern Berkshire Regional School District had 7 more students enrolled than projected. This difference is spread out among all the grades. The district is projected to lose another 221 students or 35% by 2030. Other than a slight increase in the number of students moving/choicing into the district for Kindergarten and 3<sup>rd</sup> grade, the district continues to see choicing out/moving out among all grades. The district also shows a declining birth rate for the next few years before it stabilizes beyond 2025.
