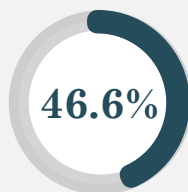
DEFINITION

Brownfields are properties that contain or *may contain* a hazardous substance, pollutant or contaminant, which complicates efforts to expand, redevelop or reuse the property. The potential or perception of contamination by petroleum products or hazardous substances is enough for a site to be considered a brownfield. Assessing, cleaning up and reinvesting in these properties improves and protects the environment.

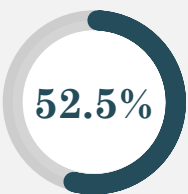
BRPC's PROGRAM

BRPC's Brownfields Program began in 2004 and includes assessment and a revolving loan fund for cleanup. BRPC also provides assistance to municipalities and nonprofits to receive assessment and cleanup funds.

Over 20 years BRPC has helped to secure 13 assessment grants, 7 cleanup grants, 2 RLF grants and 1 area wide planning grant.

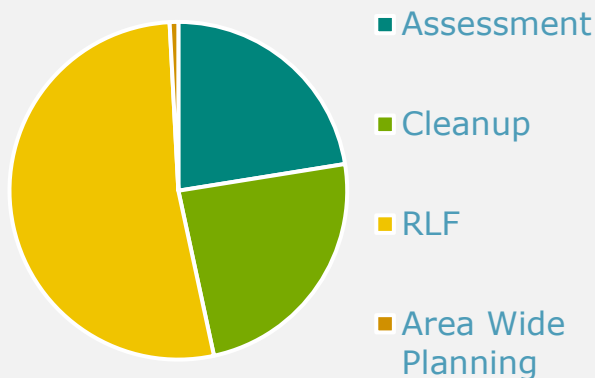

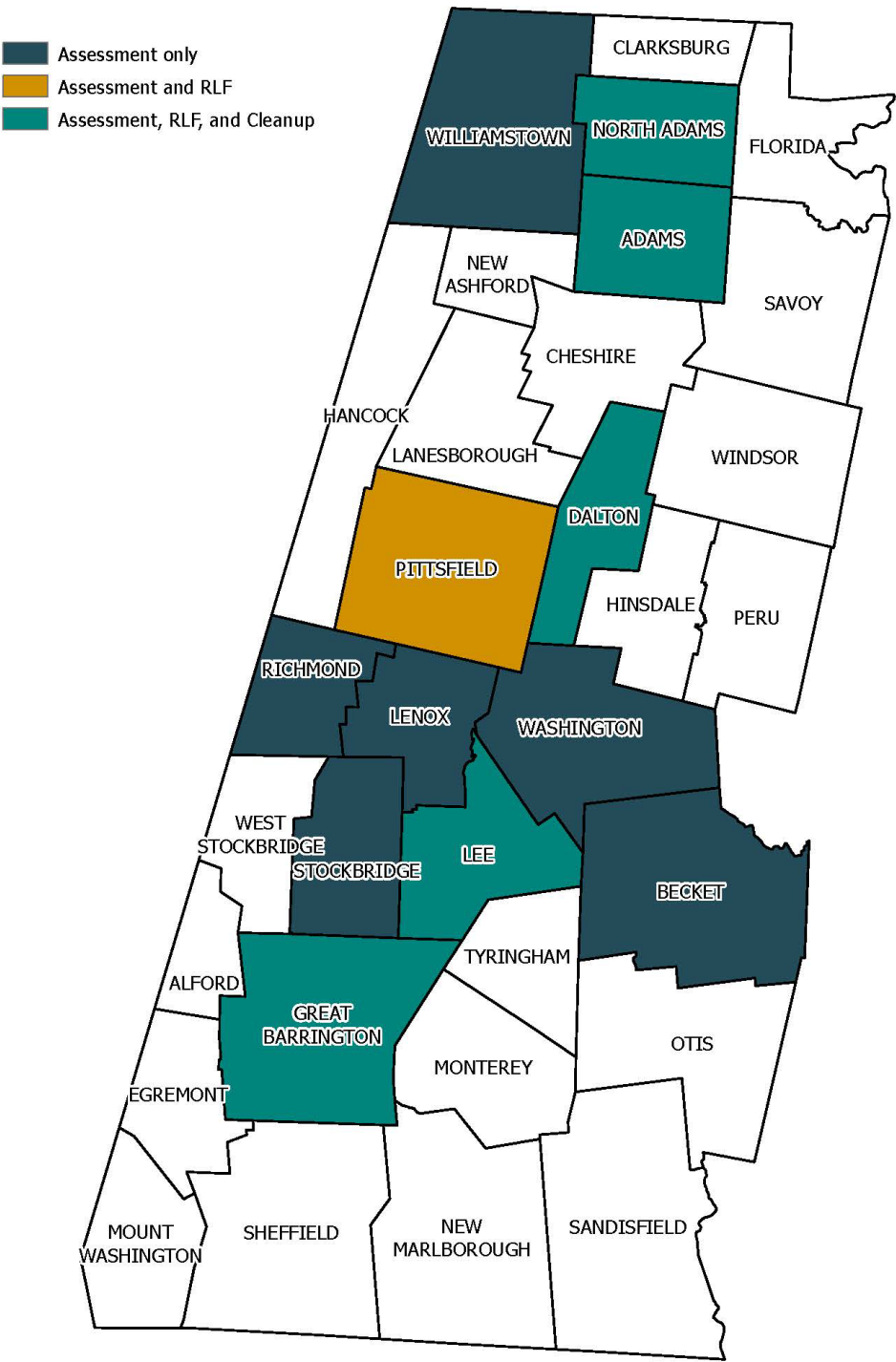

NOTEWORTHY REDEVELOPMENT PROJECTS

Hoosac Valley Coal & Grain (Adams) - Public park adjacent to Hoosic River and Ashuwillticook Rail Trail.

New England Log Homes (Great Barrington) – Bentley Apartments affordable housing in downtown.

34 Bridge Street/Former Dry Cleaner (Great Barrington) – Powerhouse Square market rate condominiums, Berkshire Co-op Market and street level commercial space.

Eagle Mill (Lee) – Currently being cleaned up and redeveloped as affordable housing.

Greylock Mill (North Adams) – Redeveloped as GreylockWORKS a mixed use space that includes events, restaurant, distillery, co-work space, culinary program and residential spaces.

Dewey Avenue Parcels (Pittsfield) – Redeveloped as the West Side Riverway Park.

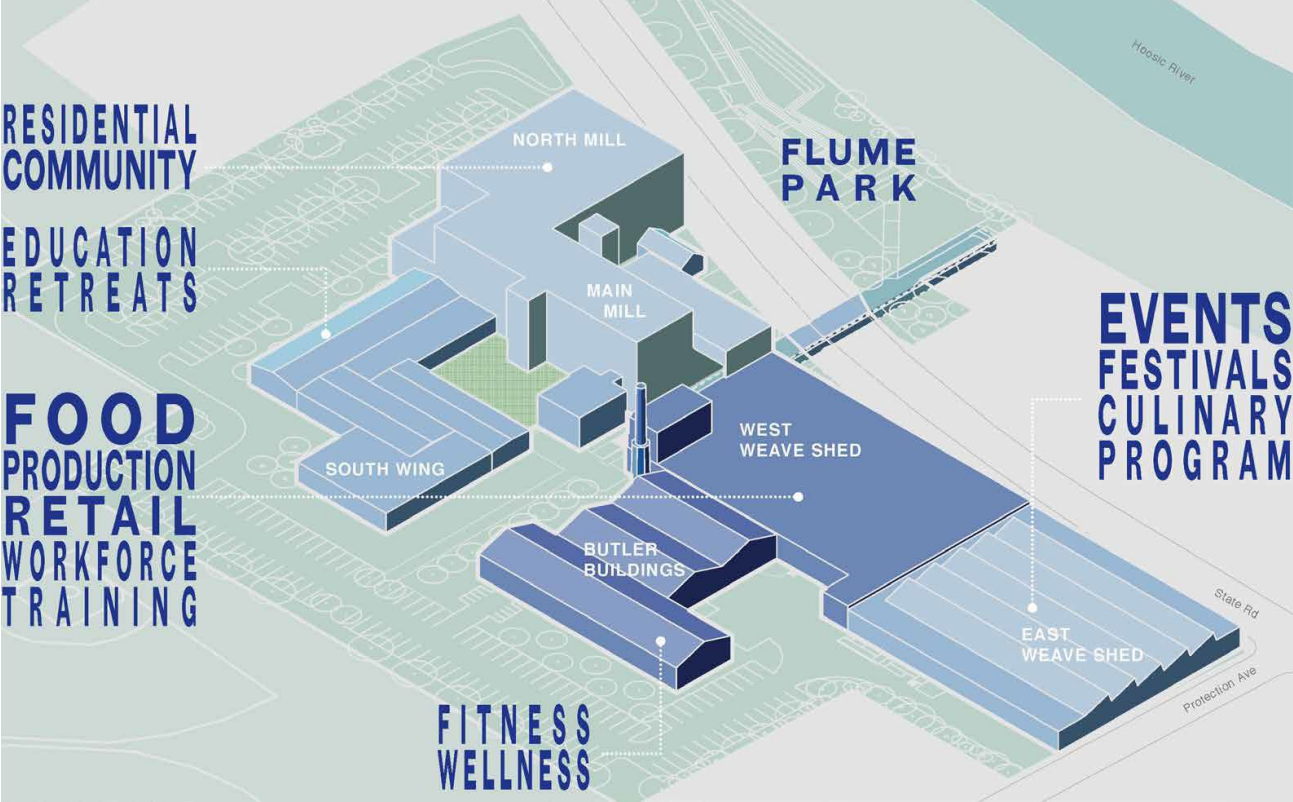
